
About the show...

The origin of *Unearth* came about while sitting in the audience at a composition competition at the conservatory. We had been tossing around show ideas for a few weeks, but very little was clear about exactly *what* it would be. Having just come from a brainstorm meeting, and with the questions of what kind of work we wanted to do still fresh in our minds, we experienced Andrew's "Celesta Quintet" for the first time. Midway through the piece, we turned to one another, eyes wide, and knew we were both thinking the same thing:

"This *needs* to be a piece of theater."

Since then, we have had the immense privilege of devising this piece with 6 other incredible women. This project has been a "first rehearsal" for many of us in discovering ourselves as devisers and movers. At the beginning of this process, we asked the cast to begin getting curious about themselves and the things they do or don't let themselves want. In the wise words of Mark Lewis, "it takes great bravery to want something in front of other people." As young adults, we are living between childhood and adulthood. We find ourselves wrestling with want almost constantly- caught, like most, between dream and reality, hope and fear, possible and impossible. This piece is an exploration of the in-between.
